- Place the baby's hands near the face in a flexed position.
- Pull one strap over the baby's shoulder and arm to help hold the baby's hands in a comfortable, flexed position near his face.
- Tuck the strap under the Disposable Snuggly ROO so the weight of the baby will hold it in place.
- Pull the strap on the opposing side over the other shoulder and arm to assist with maintaining appropriate flexion and tuck under. In side-lying, the second strap may not be needed.
- In order to maintain the desired position, the caregiver may use a Polly PAL, Dandle PAL or Cozy Cub to give the baby support at the head and keep the baby from kicking out of the foot roll.
- Check all lines and tubes after positioning the baby to ensure proper and secure placement.

NOTE: If greater visualisation of the baby is needed, the straps may be placed off to the side.
